We are aware that under the Regulation of Imports and Exports Regulation 1995, with effect from 1 December 1995, the penalty for making a false declaration in respect of any such Certificate, permit, or certification is a fine of up to S\$100,000 or three (3) times the value of the goods, whichever is greater or up to two (2) years' imprisonment or both for the first offense. For the second or subsequent offense, the penalty is a fine of up to S\$200,000 or four (4) times the value of the goods whichever is greater or three (3) years' imprisonment or both.
